

**Parnassiaceae (Grass-of-Parnassus Family)**

**Look Alikes:** *P. fimbriata* and *P. parviflora* have larger petals with 5-13 veins, and a bract-like leaf on the stem.


**Flowering/Fruiting Period:** June-July/July-August.

**Habitat:** Subalpine and alpine wet, rocky ledges, in streamlets and moss mats.  
Elev. 10,000-12,000 ft.

**Distribution:** Northeast Asia, Alaska, Yukon, east to Labrador, Greenland south to Washington, Nevada, Wyoming and Colorado (Boulder, Clear Creek, Grand, Larimer, Park, San Juan and Summit Cos.).
