- 1b. Plants with seeds2
- 2a. Leaves needle-like, scale-like, evergreen, seeds on scales, conesPines, Firs, Junipers
- 2b. Seeds in an ovary, flowering plants3
- 3a. Plants insectivorous, parasitic, saprophyticSundew, bladderworts, some orchids
- 3b. Plants with green leaves4
- 4a. Plants submerged or floating.....Aquatics
- 4b. Plants terrestrial or emergent5
- 5a. Trees, Shrubs, Vines.....Box elder, Willows, Cottonwoods, Tamarisk, Russian Olive
- 5b. Herbaceous6
- 6a. Leaves parallel-veined, flowers in 3s, vascular bundles scattered....Monocots (grasses, sedges, rushes, orchids, cattails)
- 6b. Leaves net-veined, flowers in 4s or 5s, vascular bundles in ringsDicots (daisies, hemlock, mints, smartweeds, roses, buttercups)
